Please consider the comments herein as the official response from the Greater Maple Valley Area Council (GMVAC) regarding the additional proposed changes to <u>Chapter 3--Rural Area & Natural Resource Lands, Il--Rural Densities and Development; Section C--Transfer of Development Rights (TDR) Program; (pp. 3-14 to 3-15) of the King County Comprehensive Plan Update for 2008.</u>

We support the **TDR changes** contained in R-212 to R-215 and R-216 as they offer Rural Area landowners *additional* options should they wish to use them.
