



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The executive is requested to:

- A. Establish a new department of local services to be operational by January 1, 2019;
- B. Prepare the 2019-2020 executive proposed budget reflective of a department of local services and related changes to other King County departments, funds and rates;
- C. Form a transition team to recommend organizational, operational and other changes to the executive, and be available to brief the council's standing and regional committees;
- D. Develop and transmit an ordinance that would amend K.C.C. chapter 2.16 to establish a department of local services with emphasis on:
  1. Improving the coordination of local services by King County agencies through increased collaboration;
  2. Strengthening and expanding partnerships between the county, communities and other entities;
  3. Improving the delivery, responsiveness and quality of local services to the people, businesses and communities of unincorporated King County through unified accountability;
  4. Improving local services through robust employee engagement while embracing equity and social justice and continuous improvement;
  5. Strengthening unincorporated communities by supporting local planning and community initiatives;and
  6. Pursuing innovative funding strategies; and
- E. Develop and transmit legislation addressing funds, fund management and financial policies and other legislation as appropriate to the county organizational change.
