Informal Comment Period—Draft Rule Changes August 2019

On-site Sewage Systems Chapter 246-272A WAC



Background

WAC 246-272A directs the Washington State Department of Health (DOH) to review the on-site sewage systems (OSS) rule every four years and make a recommendation to the State Board of Health (SBOH) for the need to revise the rule. In January 2018, the SBOH directed DOH to begin the rule revision process.

DOH formed the On-site Rule Revision Committee (ORRC), a group of industry professionals, local health professionals, and other interested stakeholders. The ORRC met regularly from June 2018 through August 2019 to advise DOH on policy and technical issues which helped inform the revised rule language.

Informal Comment Period

A six-week informal comment period will be open **August 27-October 8**. A draft version of the revised rule and other materials, including a section-by-section highlight of draft changes, will be available on our <u>rulemaking webpage</u> during this period. The informal comment period will also include a series of **six statewide 3-hour workshops** hosted by DOH to help clarify proposed changes and answer questions.
