

The Greater Maple Valley Unincorporated Area Council (GMVUAC) is a Washington non-profit organization initially created in 1977; its service area is unincorporated King County within the Tahoma School District #409 boundaries (i.e., excludes the City of Maple Valley) that includes roughly 16.000 residents and 116 square miles; is composed of volunteer citizens who are elected to serve four year terms and attend monthly meetings; and is a local body that advocates for local residents on various issues including land use planning and zoning, economic and small business interests, State and County legislative and regulatory programs (e.g., onsite sewage and water supply), traffic and other infrastructure concerns, and specific development proposals (including residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural).

The Council meets the first Monday of every month (except legal holidays, it meets the 2nd Monday) at 7:00 p.m. at the Maple Valley Fire Station #81, intersection of SR 169 and SE 231st Street in Maple Valley.
