1. Purpose of KC DLS invitation to 12/7 Monthly meeting (7:07)

2. Issues/ Questions to DLS (7:18)

- Permitting:
  - Permitting did not satisfactory answer question, for example Trench Filling, lot of questions remain.
  - What is permitting's job? Do they have enough of a budget to do that job?
  - Up-zones, why can't permitting determine something is illegal? How long does that take?
  - How do we find out about other concerns the GMVUAC should know about?
  - Rimbo will ask questions to permitting.
- Environment:
  - There are questions about Cedar Hills Landfill and Queen City Farms.

- Focus should be on process.
- Landfill may be too big of a topic for Monday- landfill should have its own meeting.
- The following Motion was offered:

Motion: Rimbo- Motion for Hiester to ask- What is John Taylor's role in working with other King County Departments to get things accomplished? Second: Haynes, Approved – Unanimous.

- Transportation:
  - Elk Heights
  - Ravensdale intersection- Cost of stoplight at intersection?
  - Haul Route Agreements- Does Permitting and Roads talk about Haul Route Agreements with each other?
  - Why Does the Utility Fee go to the general fund and not back to roads?
  - Harvey will ask questions to Roads.
