1. Public Comments (7:06)

- Lisa Floyd King County DCHS/ Behavioral health and recovery Division (BHRD).
 - King County Council to start short term project to expand services to the King County Rural Area.
 - Survey out in mid-March to those on email list.
 - o Going to have a few community engagement focus groups- no dates yet.
- 2. TSD Update-- Val Paganelli (TSD Board Member) (7:11):
- K-5 is now is session in either half day or 100% remoter by choice.
- Targets middle school in march, high school in April.
- 100% Zoom/ Hybrid so students can participate at the same time.
- Overview of capital projects fund, \$6-8 million to update HVAC/ roofing/ carpet.
- District got \$7 million from state refund for the construction of the high school- holding onto rest of capital funds until they get demographers report.
- Currently working on 5-year goal and targets- will be through 2026.
- 5-6% of students above average have fallen off with at least one "F" grade.
- There is statewide legislation to wave requirements to graduate.
- TSD still using guidance from Public Health's decision tree.
- TSD is doing contact tracing to limit the spread of Covid-19.
- Covid-19 testing site at high school.

- Q. The seniors looking at post-graduation, how is that being handled at this time, what happened last year?
- A. Val will take back to District and report back.

- John Taylor sent out to all the UAC's a Community Service Needs request.
- Public relations had a meeting to discuss.
- Rimbos also sent an email to Marissa with 10-20 questions- Marissa sent to Daneille de Clercq.
- Trying to figure out what DLS want, what are they looking for?
- Danielle- This is the first time we are doing this, it is an attempt by DLS and the Council to find out what the community needs/ wants.
- DLS is supposed to engage with the community to find out what we need.
- Planning to review feedback to see what the county can do, when they can do it and start to budget for it.
- If there are suggestions that is not County work, DLS would try and guide to other resources who would help with that issue.
- DLS is going to try and look into and respond to each request.

- How is the GMVUAC going to approve comments so Rimbos can submit them to GMPC?
- Rimbos- One idea would be to change bylaws to restructure how things are approved.
- Buchanan- Have a prescheduled standing meeting in case we need it.
- Rimbos- Our meetings are based on the project at hand, each with its own unique timeline.
- GMVUAC will hold a special meeting March 8, 2021 (dependent on the MCCC meeting also on March 8, 2021).
- Executive committee should meet to discuss bylaws.
- Action item to the committees- mission vision and policies.
- 3 Committees create a list of what our beliefs are in order to serve as a GMVUAC "roadmap".
