 - o In the transportation package that passed, transportation is not fully funded.
 - Have to figure out how to supplement the budget.
 - o Gas tax is main source of income.
 - o Transportation package to get more money.

- 16-year plan to add funding.
- o 16 billion over 16 years of additional funding.
- 1/3 of that funding to decrease carbon in transportation.
- o Locally, HWY 18, 640 million to make it 4 lanes from Issaquah-Hobart to 190.
- o This will be 2 parts, part one is under contract.
- Part 1: I90 interchange and start 4 lanes.
- o Part 2: finish the 4 lanes.
- Construction is 5-6 years.
- Main point is to have a divided highway.
- Hwy 18 is one of the deadliest in the state.
