- 1. Public Comments (7:011): N/A.
- 2. Local Conservation Futures Terry Lavender (7:12):
- Conservation Future= property tax, never collected from 1971 until 1982.
- State allows up to 6.25% per \$1000- KC did until 2005.
- 2005 limited collections, beyond 1% increase had to be voted.
- This year is 3.25% next year below 3%.
- Vote will be for one time reset to 6.25% and then go down from there.
- Fund only buys from willing sellers.
- \$825,000 is average for KC or about \$23.99
- Reset will increase this to \$51.95 or around \$4.23 per month.
- All commercial properties pay this tax.
- More trees/parks/salmon/farms.
- Everyone in KC votes for it.
- Everyone pays the same rate.
- About 50% will be spent on land in urban areas.
- About 50% will be spent on land in rural areas.
- Terry is seeking endorsement from the GMVUAC.
