

## Phase One Engagement-Scoping and Vision

The key priorities identified for this initial phase were:

- Introducing staff and the project to the community.
- Asking open-ended questions to understand community members' aspirations.
- Learning with curiosity through interviews and conversations.
- Establish transparency and communicate with the public about the program and process.

- Mandated by KCC
- Three phases
  - Phase 1: data collection (complete)
  - Phase 2: analyze inequities (in progress)
  - Phase 3: address/mitigate inequities (not started)
- Initial findings in preliminary plan
